

"WHO warns against homeopathy use"

LMHI Statement to the WHO

At the beginning of June 2009, the UK pressure group "Sense about Science", acting on behalf of the lobby network "The Voice of Young Science" (VoYS), sent an open letter to different departments of the World Health Organization (WHO) about "Homeopathy and serious diseases in the developing world".

The group called on the WHO ... to condemn the promotion of homeopathy for treating TB, infant diarrhoea, influenza, malaria and HIV. The British organization later claimed that several directors of WHO departments had responded to their letters by saying that current WHO guidelines do not recommend the use of homeopathy and that there is no place for homeopathic medicines for serious diseases such as HIV, TB,

and malaria. In mid-August, the same pressure group distributed a letter to Health Ministries around the world in which they affirmed that WHO has published official advice against homeopathy in this matter. The media published this news as "Homeopathy not a cure, says WHO", "WHO warns against homeopathy use", "WHO Sounds Alarm on Homeopathy".

The LMHI, the world's largest organization of homeopathic medical doctors, expressed concern about this development in a letter that LMHI President Dr. Ulrich D. Fischer sent to WHO Director General Dr. Margaret Chan in late September. He called on Dr. Chan to specify the WHO's position on homeopathic medicines and to take a position on the claims made by "Sense about Science". Fischer emphasized that several pilot studies demonstrate the effectiveness of homeopathy in treating epidemic diseases but

Dear LMHI-Members, Dear Readers,

Once more, homeopathy has come under attack. This time. the World Health Organization (WHO) itself has been involved by falling victim to a ruthless and persistent campaign that has used a well-respected organization to discredit homeopathy. The fact, however, is that homeopathic medicine is used within an official and legally recognized framework by licensed physicians in 17 countries of the world and is in current use in more than 80 countries. Nonetheless, global networking is becoming an essential and indispensable factor of ever growing importance. It is the cooperation of homeopathic physicians worldwide that will contribute to the LMHI's mission of taking an active part to maintain and improve the health of human beings across national boarders. This commitment has been clearly demonstrated at the meetings of the LMHI governing bodies in Warsaw/Poland which took place prior to the 64th World Medical Congress 2009. Global collaboration requires a constant process of coordination and readjustment of common goals. The LMHI is well-prepared to meet this challenge. A date for the next LMHI reunion has already been determined: Redondo Beach, L.A./USA, May 18-22, 2010.

also pointed to the fact that much more research is needed in order to increase the amount of evidence proving the efficacy of homeopathic treatment of diseases such as HIV/ Aids, malaria and TB.

Homeopathy Complements Available Conventional Treatment

In his letter, Fischer stated explicitly that it is not the policy of any homeopathic organization in the world to advise patients against the use of conventional medicine – in contrast to networks like Sense about Science that try to discredit homeopathy by using a well-respected organization such as the WHO. Homeopathic medicine is

used within an official and legally recognized framework by licensed physicians in 17 countries of the world, and it is in current use in more than 80 countries. Moreover, national medicine authorities in Europe are working together to harmonize the registration procedures for homeopathic medicines. The WHO itself is represented in the meetings of the "Homeopathic Medicinal Products Working Group" (HMPWG) that is supervised by the European "Heads of Medicines Agencies" (HMA).

Up-to-Date Information and Communication Platform

In its first six months of operation, the new LMHI-Webseite www.lmhi.net has not only become a wellaccepted platform for providing up-to-date information on current homeopathic topics, but also thanks to its interactive content management system the webpage has been lively used as a forum for questions related to LMHIspecific issues. On the one hand, there were numerous requests for LMHI membership, in particular from India, as well as subscriptions to the electronic newsletter. Another homeopathic doctor from India has asked the LMHI for help in developing an organization in Orissa, which is the poorest state of India. On the other hand, the organizer of the 67th LMHI Congress in Japan in 2012 used the contact form for questions concerning LMHI Congress organization. Other interested parties are seeking specific information on homeopathic topics. For example, the head librarian of the Medical Library University of Zurich, Switzerland, was looking - on behalf of the Professor for Alternative Medicine at the University of Zurich - for a paper published in the Proceedings of the 49th LMHI Congress, 1995, New Delhi. Such e-mails requesting specific information are always forwarded to the responsible members of the LMHI Executive Committee

Report about the meetings of the Executive Committee and the International Council

LMHI Governing Bodies meet in Warsaw

Prior to the 64th LIGA Congress in Warsaw/Poland, the LMHI's governing bodies met on 25-26 August 2009 to share impressions, ideas, and proposals about the policy and the future of the LIGA. At the meeting of the International Council, about 25 countries were represented by their National Vice Presidents, India being represented even with three delegates and various assistants. The atmosphere was friendly and constructive with a lot of impulses for the future of Homeopathy in the world. The upcoming congresses in Redondo Beach, California/USA (May 2010), in Riga/Latvia (May 2011) and in Nara/Japan (2012) were planned and the Executive Committee welcomed the opportunity to meet with all three national organizing teams. Important topics were discussed and adopted during the political meetings, such as the LMHI/ ECH Curriculum (Medical Homeopathic Education Standards) through which the recognition of a common worldwide educational curriculum by many homeopathic schools and medical associations worldwide will be possible. The new Guidelines for Liga Congress Organization, adopted by both the Executive Committee and the International Council, will help to improve the quality of future LMHI Congresses even further. A position paper on the definition of the homeopathic remedy has been discussed and returned to the Secretaries for Research and for Pharmacy for further discussion. It was also decided that, from now on, a Homeopathy Day will take place each year – organized by the LMHI and ECH as well. LMHI and ECH will be present with their Executive Committee for support, lectures and talks with authorities. The Homeopathy Day will take place – each year – in a different country, starting in April 2010 with Slovenia.

Intensive talks and discussions took place between the Executive Committee and the delegates of the most important Indian medical homeopathic associations. The results are positive and will improve the communication and collaboration of our Indian colleagues with the LMHI. For the first time a meeting of the Executive Committee with the Presidents of the National Homeopathic Medical Associations took place during the Warsaw Congress. The members of the Executive Committee presented their respective working areas. It was also a good occasion for

many representatives of homeopathic associations to describe the situation of homeopathy in their countries and to express suggestions and proposals for a better presence of the Liga in their respective countries.

Considering that the communication between the National Vice Presidents and the National Homeopathic Associations as well as with the Executive Committee of the LMHI is not always free of disturbances, this meeting offered a good occasion to improve the relationship between LMHI and the member countries of the LIGA.

CALL for ELECTIONS

On the occasion of the 65th LMHI Congress in Redondo Beach, California, USA, elections of the LMHI Executive Committee will take place.

The procedures for the Elections of the LMHI Executive Committee are defined as follows:

- The Call for Elections shall be made at the International Council Meeting in the year prior to the International Council Meeting at which the elections will take place and shall be published in the next issue of *The Liga Letter*. (This Call occurred at the recent International Council Meeting in Warsaw and is hereby published in this *Liga Letter*.)
- 2) Three months prior to the Elections, the candidates for posts on the Executive Committee must send in writing to the LMHI General Secretary their *curriculum vitae* and their reasons for standing for the post.

- (These documents should be sent to LMHI Prime General Secretary Dr. Renzo Galassi at renzogala@ libero.it by 18 February 2010.)
- 3) The Prime General Secretary of the Liga shall distribute the list of Executive Candidates to all of the members of the International Council with the Agenda that is mailed one month prior to the International Council Meeting.
- 4) The Elections shall take place during the International Council Meeting that coincides with the Liga Medicorum Homeopathica Internationalis Congress.
- 5) By means of a written ballot, the Elections shall be carried out by a secret vote in which *each International Council member* is entitled to participate.
- 6) It is advisable that the candidate for a post on the Executive Committee has been a member of the Liga in good standing for three years.

New European Library for Homeopathy in Köthen (Anhalt)/Germany is celebrated by renowned international homeopaths

The opening of the new European Library for Homeopathy was celebrated in the German city of Köthen on October 9, 2009, in the presence of the renowned international homeopaths Dr. André Saine (Canada), Dr. Carlos Néstor Cámpora (Argentina) and Dr. K. S. Srinivasan and Prof. D. P. Rastogi (India). Samuel Hahnemann, the founder of Homeopathy, lived and practiced in Köthen from 1821 to 1835. Dr. Srinivasan announced that he will donate about 200 dissertations from India to the literary stock of the library and stated that "This building is meant to become the heart of Homeopathy in the world."

The reconstruction of the neo-classical library building, constructed in 1829 as the Monastery of the Merciful Brethren and situated close to Hahnemann's former residence, is the most important project of the International Building Exhibition (IBA) 2010 in Köthen. Under the title "Homeopathy as a Healing and Developmental Force in Urban Planning", Köthen has developed a strategic profile that backs health-care as an economic factor of growing importance and takes up the city's crucial role in the history of homeopathy. Convinced that the principles and teachings of homeopathy can also be applied to urban planning and development, an interdisciplinary team of homeopathic doctors and city planners have been working on theoretical and empirical studies on this theory. The homeopathic doctors are interested in discovering the extent to which their methodology may be transferred to other complex systems such as those of the city.



A magnet for homeopathic literature and a new centre for homeopathy

The importance of the new Library for Homeopathy is intimately connected with its inventory of books that currently consists of nearly 6,000 volumes of homeopathic literature – including special rarities from the years 1796

to 1950. It combines expertise and European resources using duplicates and books from private and closed-down libraries. Dr. Jutta Hübner, head of the EBH, highlighted that "The European Library has already become a magnet for homeopathic literature, given the extraordinary amount of book donations by private people as well as by associations and institutions." The library offers room for a total of 12.000 volumes.

The European Library for Homeopathy is committed to tradition, bringing homeopathy back to where it started and thus "closing a historic cycle". At the same time, however, the European Library is turning towards the future

as it is part of a new centre for homeopathy. Along with the library, Köthen has established itself as a location for further education in the field of homeopathy. In cooperation with the University of Magdeburg, a Masters Course of Homeopathy will be offered starting in the winter term 2010/2011 – the first of its kind in Germany. The courses are held in the historic Lutze Clinic.


This lively exchange of homeopathic knowledge and experience is meant to be for the benefit of future homeopaths.

65th LMHI-Congress Redondo Beach, California/USA 18-22 May 2010



2010 marks the 200th anniversary of Samuel Hahnemann's Organon of Medicine. The 65th Congress of the LMHI – that will take place from 18-22 May 2010 in Redondo Beach, California/USA – wants to honor the past and the

marvelous ideals of Hahnemann, but also to emphasize the present and future. "Of course, Truth is timeless," says Richard Hiltner, the Congress Organizer and President of the Californian Homeopathic Society, "but one must hold on to ideals until a legitimate truth requires one to have the courage and wisdom to change." A copy of the original 5th edition of the Organon – with Hahnemann's handwriting – is planned to be given to all congress participants.

Special topics will include: Miasms: What Evidence in Modern Medicine; Treatment of Cancer and Autoimmune Diseases. Pediatrics and Immunization Studies: Materia

Medica: The Snake Remedies; Evidence Based Homeopathy; Provings; Veterinary and Dentistry Homeopathy, and Open Topics.

Interview with Congress Organiser Richard Hiltner, M. D.



The motto of the congress is "A homeopathic Odyssey". What associations does this have?

The main theme for the 65th LIGA Congress is 2010: A Homeopathic Odyssey which draws from the famous epic poem of Homer in the sense

that Odysseus must undergo many trails and tribulations in order to obtain his triumphs – so with homeopathy. There are few sciences that have had to endure such tremendous ordeals as homeopathic medicine. However, there is another reason why this theme was chosen which centers more on the place where this Congress will be held – California, Redondo Beach in the Los Angeles area and the international home of movie entertainment. There was a famous movie called *2001: A Space Odyssey* and a sequel



done with the year 2010. This "play on words" again has a theme of tests and challenges, but also a sense of the Future and the exploration of the unknown knowledge in this universal, harmonious and natural approach to medicine.

What is special about the upcoming LIGA 2010 Congress in California?

It is the 200^{th} anniversary of the Organon. We are hoping to give copies of the original 5^{th} edition of the Organon to all attendees. It is a beautiful place, central and with much entertainment, art, culture and ocean views. California has a tradition of promoting ideas that lead to greater and more innovative development of human consciousness and health.

What are the main topics of the Congress?

What kind of cultural/social program will be offered for congress participants and associates?


