C4 proving workshop
C4 trituration provings

Thursday 9 May, 2019, 9.30 hrs – 17.00 hrs
Registration deadline 26 February, 2019
Maximum number of participants: 26

Since the early 90's, C4 trituration provings are conducted by homeopaths to obtain first hand experience with materia medica and its sources of knowledge. ECH's Proving Committee organises this workshop for homeopathic physicians to gain more experience for ECH in order to better serve the homeopathic community, and for educators who consider to include the subject into their training program.

Participants will personally triturate and observe reactions to an unknown remedy during a morning (C3) session and an afternoon (C4) session. reactions can include reference to signature as well as impulses to move, or specific expressions e.g. in drawings, etc. A comparison with existing experiences on preceding C1 and C2 sessions by others is available after this day. No long standing adverse reactions have been observed in a series of 100 trituration provings over the last 20 years.

The C4 proving as a method is sometimes connected with special theories or interpretative frameworks. During this workshop direct experience is relevant, although theories may occasionally be touched shortly.

The proving will be guided by Susanne Diez, a homeopathic doctor from Austria, who has 20 years of experience with the conduction of trituration provings in a long standing Austrian group of homeopaths. Her presentation about theoretical aspects of C4 provings during the ECH workshop in Sofia last November was well received.

These topics are interesting for homeopathic pharmacists and for homeopathic doctors as well. The workshop will be led by Ilse Muchitsch, ECH Pharmacy Subcommittee Coordinator, and Susann Buchheim, pharmacist and lecturer at "School for pharmaceutical technical assistants Dr. Künkele" in Mainz (Germany). Morning Programme

- 1. Presentation on similarities and differences amongst homeopathic pharmacopoeias worldwide (Synopsis)**
- 2. Presentation on different potentisation methods for dilutions:**
 - Manual dilution (GHP) versus mechanic potentizing machines (FP) vs. korsakovian potentisation in practice and via movies
 - Discussion on possible consequences for the remedy/ influence number of the strokes
- 3. Trituration from fresh plants versus usage of a standardised, analysed mother tincture - pros and cons**

Advantage of mother tinctures as starting material for further preparations

Afternoon Programme

- 4. Practice: Preparation of a LM potency**
 - Trituration from C2 up to C3 in pairs of "Tinctura acris sine kali", a forgotten Hahnemannian remedy from "Fragmenta de viribus medicamentorum positivis sive in sano corpore humano observatis"
 - Demonstration of preparation of a LM/ Q- potency starting from C3 trituration
 - Impregnation of pillules (GHP method)
- 5. Report from the World Integrated Medicine Forum in Goa on regulation of homeopathic medicinal products "harmonization"-tendencies in homeopathic pharmacy and industry**
